**Rick Wilson** has been a serious performer, student, and collector of historical flutes since 1977. He studied baroque flute with Stephen Preston in London and has appeared in the Los Angeles area with groups such as the Harmonia Baroque Players, Los Angeles Baroque Orchestra, and Con Gioia. His collection of over 120 antique flutes includes representatives of almost every important flute "system," from the keyless flutes of the Renaissance to the highly-mechanized reform flutes of the early twentieth century.

Rick's web site (http://www.oldflutes.com) is an early flute resource that attracts viewers from all over the world. He is currently Professor of Mathematics at the California Institute of Technology.
